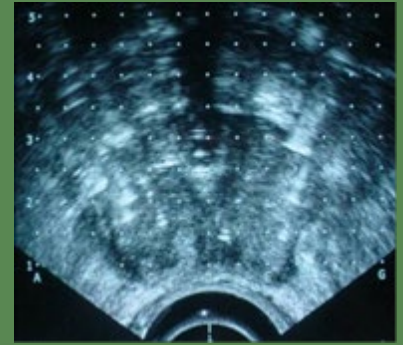


Study days at Allied Health and Applied Sciences



Ultrasound-Guided Prostate Brachytherapy

- Gaining Competency – A Non-Sonographer's View point
- Developing training competencies

- wanting to refresh their knowledge and skills
- wishing to top-up their in-house training
