Benefits to your practice:	<p>The newsletter questions were based on 2 papers – disease progression in PVD and TBI in PVD.</p> <p>The TBI paper was particularly useful to our practice as we had acquired a toe pressure kit from Huntleigh technology a few months earlier.</p> <p>The paper reminded me that diagnostic criteria for a pathological TBI remains ambiguous and the cut off of <0.7 is not strictly evidence based.</p> <p>Also toe pressure measurements are susceptible to vaso constriction and should be performed at a stable temperature.</p>
Benefits to service user:	<p>It was my responsibility to train our radiology department assistants to perform toe pressures and also to provide training for podiatry who bought a toe pressure kit for use in their diabetic clinic. One of our vascular nurse specialists was also keen to use the toe pressure kit.</p> <p>The information from the paper helped to achieve consistency of results by ensuring all toe pressures were measured at a stable temperature.</p>
