Subject Thoracic Outlet Manoeuvres

Power point presentation given followed by discussion, this was taken from the nice guidelines.

Outcome:-

Brachial artery or distal subclavian may be used to assess a change in flow patterns. If Brachial is positive, attempt to assess Subclavian on significant side and assess other side.

Positions for manoeuvres appear to vary so carefully state what manoeuvres you have used. These will be clearly explained in the protocol and Roos manoeuvre will be added to assessment list. (MY action)

If the examination is negative it is acceptable to provide a written report on PACS (MY to produce template?)

Royal College of surgeon's website provided no further significant information applicable to us.

AC is to contact the Southampton surgeons to find out who is the TOS lead and ask them to come and talk to us or email with their requirements for the assessments.

CR to contact Ellie to find out about the Bristol protocol/ clinics.
