

To whom it may concern,

I am writing to confirm that as of 11<sup>th</sup> February 2016, Ved Ramnani has mastered surveillance scanning of complex endovascular aneurysm repair grafts, to the enhanced protocol we have agreed, and has cascaded training to colleagues in order to implement this across the department.

In addition to the typical EVAR surveillance protocol, this involves evaluating the mesenteric and renal arteries for development of any subclinical stenosis due to angulation/migration, which may precede endoleak. This is a boon to our service and I am incredibly grateful to him for taking this on, allowing us to offer a better service to patients with fenestrated devices.
