	working on the creation of an European Society of Nurses and				
	Sonographers. While this project is still in the early days, the European				
	Society for Vascular Surgery invited us to organise specific sessions for				
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	nurses and sonographers during the surgeons' annual meeting in Lyon,				
	France. I attended as an invited speaker and presented some case				
	studies in carotid arteries. This talk was followed by an ultrasound

	meetings with other members of this steering group (from Sweden and				
	Denmark) and with the executive committee of the European Society for				
	Vascular Surgery.

	surgeons can only be beneficial for patients because more aspects
