Personal Reflection:

Paper 1: Role of U/S and coloured Doppler examination in the diagnosis and classification of superficial soft tissue vascular anomalies. Good review of the types of vascular anomalies, how they present on ultrasound and treatment options.

Paper 2: Transcatheter Arterialisation of Deep Veins in chronic Limb threatening Ischemia. This study looked at how placing a stent into an artery from a vein in the tibial vessels, creating fistula flow helped improve vascularisation in ischemic limbs. It had a success rate of 66.1% keeping patients amputation free for 6 months and although it's not a procedure I have ever seen performed I can see that it may become an option in future treatments offered to our patients.
