Reading both the articles was very interesting and informative. I am now more familiar with Multigated quality Doppler profile technology and its potential to be a complementary investigation to DUS and its previous areas of use, which I plan to investigate further to see if there are areas to explore for either clinical or research work in our department. The second article on the reappraisal of the use of tilt tables in venous disease was also a very interesting study, especially the results relating to venous drainage index in assessing outflow in the iliofemoral obstruction group, this was educational and our department does not have a tilt table but the usefulness of quantifying venous outflow in this group of patients is potentially very clinically useful. I plan to investigate other methods of quantifying outflow in this patient group.
