Spring 2019 CPD Questions on Venous stenting and EVLA. The papers were informative and it was interesting to learn the risks associated with Iliac stent placement causing contralateral DVT. We do not stent post Ilio-Femoral DVT in our department currently but it may be done in the future, knowing the increased risks for contralateral DVT such as IVC filters in situ, contralateral IIV thrombosis, non compliance of anticoagulation and on going malignancy causing extrinsic compression are useful. EVLA of superficial refluxing veins is encouraging for ulcer healing and reduced recurrence, this gives me confidence that our reflux imaging and subsequent treatment based on those results are extremely useful.
