In particular, haematomas and bakers cysts. This paper was very informative and it was useful to reflect on the descriptive language used to describe the pathologies and the stages of these non vascular structures in terms of chronicity. It was especially interesting to learn about the stages of a haematoma, where pockets of echoluency becomes more apparent with time alongside fibrous sepations.
