Personal Reflection:

aneurysm surveillance and the possibility of 'personalised' surveillance has been muted for many years and it is interesting that, although a possibility, there are enough unknowns and historical evidence of failing endografts that a well adhered surveillance program appears to be in the best interests of the patients. However, perhaps ceasing surveillance after a specified timescale or degree of aneurysm shrinkage may be a more palatable measure. SMI imaging will be ideal for centres without the staff groups to administer contrast medium or if CeUS is contraindicated.
