There are calcified atheromatous plaques in proximal ICA, which produce <50% stenosis. Patent distal ICA.

Left:

Soft smooth atheromatous plaques in proximal ICA, which produce 70-79% stenosis. Patent distal ICA. The stenosis is approximately 2.2cm from ICA origin and the plaques extend up to 2.8 cm from origin.
