No Sonographic evidence of significant stenosis, Post CEA .

Raised velocities distal to endarterectomy site are likely due to calibre mismatch

Antegrade vertebral artery bloodflow .

Left;

Predominantly echo poor Plaque , causing approximately 70% stenosis in the proximal ICA.

CCA PSV=64cm/s EDV=17 cm/s

ICA PSV=232cm/s EDV=73 cm/s

PSVR= 3.6 ST. Mary's ratio=13.6
