RIGHT LOWER LIMB ARTERIAL DUPLEX (QUICK URGENT SCAN FROM CARDIOLOGY ?
IATROGENIC CFA OCCLUSION)

AORTA: not assessed due to patient's condition.

RIGHT

CIA: not visualised due to bowel gas and depth.

EIA: appears patent where seen, biphasic waveforms, PSV 27cm/s.

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CFA: difficult to visualise, but mid section appears occluded.

PFA: not assessed.

SFA: weak monophasic waveforms, PSV 13-23 cm/s.

POPA: weak monophasic waveforms, PSV 10 cm/s.

ATA: weak monophasic waveforms at the ankle, PSV 9 cm/s.

PTA: weak monophasic waveforms at the ankle, PSV 8 cm/s.

ABPIs not assessed.
