RIGHT LEG

1. LSV patent and competent AK. LSV becomes incompetent 5cm BK following medial branch vein communication. Postero-medial calf VV arises from LSV 10cm BK with branches to posterior calf and antero-medial aspect of ankle. LSV patent and competent below level of VV.
2. SSV patent and competent throughout. SSV communicates with competent perforator vein at mid calf. LSV VV drains into SSV just below this level.
3. CFV, FV, POPV, PTVs and ATVs patent and competent.
