
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DUPLEX ASSESSMENT LOWER LIMB VENOUS

Conclusion:

LEFT LEG

1. Small posterior calf VV detected from KSC level, ? origin.
2. CFV patent and competent with evidence of minor old thrombus.
3. PFV at groin, FV, POPV, PTVs, ATVs, LSV and SSV patent and competent.

RIGHT LEG

1. CFV and PFV at groin patent with evidence of old thrombus.
2. FV mildly incompetent (0.7s).
3. POPV AK mildly incompetent (0.9s). POPV BK patent and competent.
4. Minor reflux detected at SPJ draining into large competent Giacomini vein. SSV patent and competent below this level.
5. Lateral thigh VV detected travelling anteriorly, ? origin.
6. PTVs, ATVs and LSV patent and competent.
