
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DUPLEX ASSESSMENT LOWER LIMB VENOUS

Conclusion:

1. IVC patent.
2. Bilateral CIVs and EIVs patent with no evidence of thrombus.
3. (L) CFV mildly incompetent (0.9s).
4. (L) FV paired. Primary (L) FV previously thrombosed with minor recanalisation and incompetent (1.4s). Accessory (L) FV patent and competent.
5. (L) POPV dilated and tortuous with evidence of old thrombus. (L) POPV incompetent (1.2s).
6. (L) PTVs incompetent (3.0s) at mid calf with evidence of old thrombus. (L) PTVs patent and competent in distal calf.
7. One (L) ATV incompetent at ankle (1.1s).
8. (L) PFV at groin, intramuscular and peroneal veins patent and competent with no evidence of thrombus.
9. (R) CFV, PFV at groin, FV, POPV, intramuscular veins, PTVs, ATVs and peroneal veins patent and competent with no evidence of thrombus.
