
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DUPLEX ASSESSMENT LOWER LIMB VENOUS

Conclusion:

LEFT LEG

1. IVC patent.
2. CIV and EIV patent with evidence of old thrombus.
3. CFV and PFV at groin patent and competent with evidence of old thrombus.
4. FV (1.3s) and POPV AK (1.1s) incompetent with evidence of old thrombus. (L) POPV mildly incompetent BK (0.8s).
5. Sapheno-femoral reflux. LSV travels out of fascia at distal thigh level. Incompetent postero-medial vein arises from LSV just BK and communicates with SSV 20cm above ankle level. LSV in fascia from mid calf level. LSV calibre 6.1mm at groin, 6.1mm AK, 4.9mm at knee and 3.0mm BK.
6. SPJ patent with minor retrograde flow into competent Giacomini vein with calf augmentation. SSV patent and competent until level of communication with incompetent postero-medial calf vein. SSV calibre 3.4mm in distal calf.
7. PTVs, ATVs and peroneal veins patent and competent.
