
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DUPLEX ASSESSMENT LOWER LIMB VENOUS

Conclusion:

RIGHT LEG

1. LSV stent at POPV anastomosis thrombosed. Flow in LSV reforms via medial branch vein 5cm AK. LSV widely patent above this level.
2. FV thrombosed with evidence of some recanalisation in proximal thigh/groin. FV paired from just below groin. Second FV patent with evidence of old thrombus. Communication from second FV to LSV (incompetent perforator vein) detected in proximal thigh.
3. CFV patent and competent with respiratory modulated waveforms.
4. PFV at groin and POPV patent and competent.

No further assessment of (R) lower limb veins.
