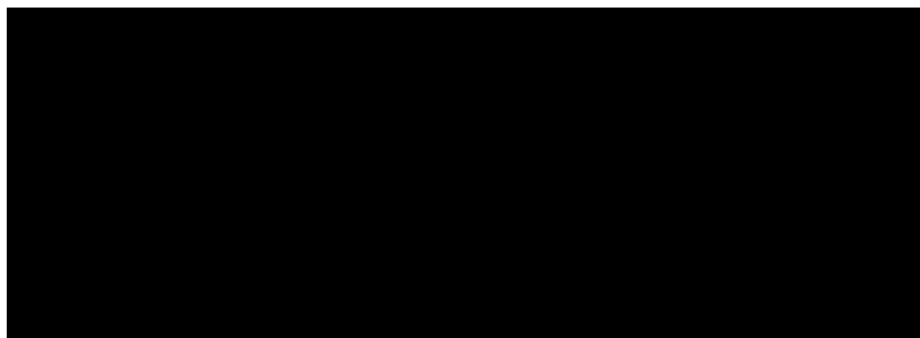

Right venous duplex scan LE

The GSV is patent and linear but incompetent with widest diameter indicated above.

The GSV became superficial probably a tributary that is incompetent and courses toward the lower leg and became tortuous and still incompetent.

The rest of the deep and superficial venous segments are patent and competent.

Left venous duplex scan LE

The GSV is patent and linear but incompetent with widest diameter indicated above.

The GSV became small in the AK segment with an incompetent tributary pierce-out of the vessel then became tortuous and spreads out toward the lower leg.

The rest of the deep and superficial venous segments are patent and competent.

Note:

The bilateral GSV are suitable for EVLT + phlebectomy.
