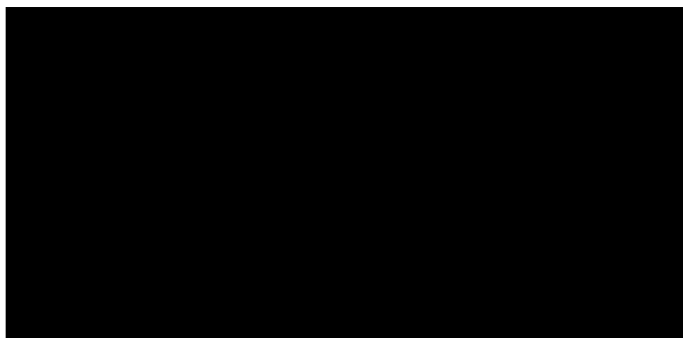

Comments : Very painful bilateral leg ulcers, right worse. Had previously right ? high tie strip and avulsion many years ago. Has normal pulses both lower limbs.

Bilateral TBPI shows normal with a pressures of 160 mmHg and an index of 1.14.

Right venous duplex scan LE

ALTB is patent but incompetent with diameter >3 mm in diameter and shows linear proximally but tortuous distally.

FV and POP shows patent but incompetent.

Non-visualization of the GSV and SPJ.

SSV, CFV and SFJ are patent and competent.

Left venous duplex scan LE

GSV is patent and linear but incompetent with widest diameter indicated above.

FV and POP are patent but incompetent.

CFV, SFJ and SSV are patent and competent. Non-visualization of the SPJ.

Note:

Patient sat on a chair while scanning. Patient unable to stand due to pain.

Right ALT B and left GSV are suitable for EVLT.
