**Notes****RIGHT LOWER LIMB VENOUS DUPLEX ASSESSMENT**

\*Unable to fully assess deep veins due to patient feeling unwell\*

Iliac veins not viewed. Flow in the common femoral vein is phasic with respiration and demonstrates a normal response on Valsalva manoeuvre, suggesting proximal vein patency.  
The CFV, PFV and SFV appear widely patent and competent with no evidence of previous DVT.  
All other deep veins not assessed due to patient not feeling well due to pain and discomfort from the calf augmentation.

SFJ is patent and incompetent.  
LSV is patent and incompetent in the thigh.

Incompetent branch noted at ~36cm from MM.

LSV is patent and incompetent in the proximal and mid calf.

Incompetent branch noted at ~15cm from MM.

LSV is patent and competent in the distal calf.

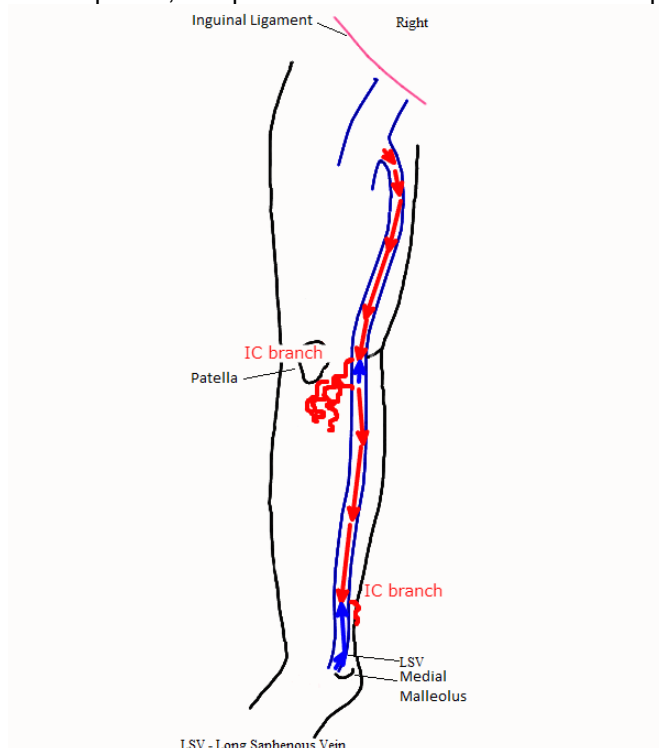
LSV measures:

Calf - 0.82, 0.71 and 0.47cm

SPJ is patent and competent.

SSV is patent, competent and is continuous with a competent vein of Giacomini.
