CFA, PFA origin, SFA and PopA - patent with mild to moderate dense and calcified disease, good bi/triphasic waveforms, PSV 61-154cm/s.

TPT - heavily calcified, however good biphasic waveforms noted.

ATA - heavily calcified. proximal to mid vessel is obscure with no colour flow noted ?due to calcification ?patency. ATA is patent at the ankle, good biphasic waveforms, PSV 34cm/s.
