LEFT LOWER LIMB VENOUS DUPLEX ASSESSMENT:

*Pulsatile flow noted in the veins

Iliac veins not viewed. Flow in the common femoral vein is pulsatile with respiration, ?cardiac problem, however appears to respond normally to a Valsalva manoeuvre, suggesting proximal vein patency. All visualised deep veins appear patent and competent with no evidence of previous DVT.

All measurements are proximal to the medial malleolus unless otherwise stated.

Sapheno-femoral junction (SFJ) appears competent. Long Saphenous vein (LSV) appears bifid from its origin. The more lateral LSV is incompetent in the proximal to mid thigh and joins the competent medial

branch in the distal thigh at 48cm. Distal to this the LSV is incompetent to the ankle. Two incompetent branches leave the fascia in the mid calf at 18cm and 17cm.

LSV lateral branch Transverse (AP) dimensions: Proximal thigh - 0.63cm, Mid - calf - 0.59cm. LSV Distal thigh - 0.57cm Proximal calf - 0.60cm, Mid - calf - 0.53cm, Distal calf - 0.40cm

Short Saphenous vein (SSV) is competent along its length.
