RIGHT:

SFJ not identified. Neo-vascularisation in the right groin reforms. The LSV is occluded proximal thigh to the mid calf and appears patent in the distal calf. An incompetent perforator noted in the proximal thigh forming

thigh varicosities. Another incompetent perforator off the medial calf varicosities noted in the mid/ distal calf.

LEFT:

SFJ appears incompetent. LSV appears incompetent in the proximal to mid thigh. A large incompetent branch leaves the fascia in the mid thigh. Distal to this the LSV is patent for a very short segment before it occludes to the very proximal calf. Non-occlusive and occlusive thrombus noted in the LSV in the proximal to mid calf. LSV reforms in the mid calf and is incompetent, tortuous and branched. An incompetent perforator off the LSV noted in the mid calf.
